SKATE PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- \*This skate park is unsupervised, therefore, the City of Loudon will not be held responsible for accidents.
- \*Know your ability and skate at your own risk. City of Loudon officials or employees will not be responsible for any injuries.
- \*Helmets and pads should be worn at all times. Skating is restricted to the skating area only.
- \*Skating against traffic on ramps or pipes is dangerous and can cause injury.
- \*Stay on ramp until clear of other skaters before dropping.
- \*Bring a buddy. Don't skate alone. There is no attendant on duty.
- \*Do not litter. Use the trash containers.
- \*Courtesy is expected at all times.
- \*Profanity and reckless and boisterous behavior will not be tolerated.
- \*Use care to avoid injury to yourself or others.
- \*Spectators are not permitted within the skating area unless supervising younger children.
- \*All noise must be kept at a respectable level. No radios or music permitted without headphones.
- \*Personal property is the responsibility of the individual skater or spectator.
- \*Do not use park if unsafe conditions are present. Report this by calling 458-7525.
- \*Graffiti, vandalism, the use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, drugs, and glass containers are not permitted in the park.
- \*No other items or objects may be used as ramps in this facility.
- \*The City of Loudon Parks and Recreation Department and the community have made a significant commitment to this facility. Please take care of your investment!
- \*Failure to follow the rules and regulations can result in serious injury and/or ejection from this facility, suspension from all of the City of Loudon recreational facilities and possible punishment to the full extent of the law.
